Acclaimed Soprano Victoria Oruwari is a London-based singer whose versatile repertoire covers art songs, operatic arias, songs from the musical theatre, traditional folksongs and jazz. Victoria's performance highlights include: Singing at the Heritage Flame Event for the lighting of the Paralympic torch at Stoke Mandville in 2016, Singing with the British Paraorchestra and the Birmingham Symphony Orchestra at the Birmingham symphony hall, Singing a duet with Jarvis Cocker as part of Charles Hazelwood's all star collective at St. George's Bristol for the BBC6 Music Festival, Performing Terry Riley's in C with the British ParaOrchestra at Colston Hall in Bristol, Playing Mrs Peachum in Graeae theatres production of Kurt Weill's "Threepenny Opera" and Singing for Liberty Festival at the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park.

Victoria also lends her voice in song to various charities: including The Liberty Human Rights UK, The Royal Society for Blind Children and The Royal National Institute of Blind People. She has performed at the Royal Festival Hall, Regents Hall, The MUSON Centre's Agip Recital Hall (Lagos, Nigeria), and has been asked to sing at various corporate and private functions at many prestigious venues.

Earlier this year she reached the finals of the popular BBC 1 Saturday night series All Together Now where her performances delighted The 100 judges, including, of course, Grenville Jones.

Victoria's accompanist is Kevin Satizabal. He was born in Popayan Colombia in 1990, and began his formal music education at the Royal College of Music Junior Department. He studied piano with Denise Patton, recorder with Sarah Humphreys, and composition with Avril Anderson.

During his time at the Royal College Kevin won various competitions including the West London pianoforte festival, the Ealing festival, was a finalist at the Royal College Teresa Carreno competition, and performed at London's Wigmore hall as one of the winners of the Jaques Samuel's Junior Intercollegiate Piano Competition in 2007.
